A few facts about Ladies' Guild:

- We are a parish organization comprised of women from the school and parish.
- School families pay their annual \$5 dues to LG and HNS in their yearly tuition. Dues cover our technology and printing costs.
- Ladies' Guild raises most of our funds at Benefit Auction and Antique Show. At the end of the year, our board votes to disburse our profits back to the school, parish and to the community.
- LG & HNS send out a weekly email newsletter with event dates, ticket sales and volunteer opportunities.
